There is a lot to like about OneDrive for Business. If you haven't yet moved files over to OneDrive for Business, here are a few reasons why you should.



BACK-UP AVAILABLE ON ALL DEVICES

OneDrive for Business is the default document library in a user's My Sites in SharePoint Server 2013 or SharePoint Online. The contents of this library can optionally be synchronized with one or more of the user's computers or devices.

By using OneDrive for Business, you can help ensure that business files for your users are stored in a central location. Storing business files in one location makes it easy for users to share and collaborate on documents. If you're using Office 365 for enterprises, you can also reduce your on-premises storage costs by moving your users' files to the cloud.



SECURITY

Online storage services for personal files are user-owned and are great for storing and sharing your latest vacation pictures, but they usually lack the security and encryption needed to store and share your company's business files. Making users aware of differences, such as security measures, helps them understand why they should use OneDrive for Business for documents that are important to their work and to the organization.

ADMIN CENTER

The **OneDrive Admin Center** portal has sections labeled "Home," "Sharing," "Sync," "Storage," "Device Access" and "Compliance." Here's what's enabled by those sections:



HOME
Features a dashboard showing overall OneDrive for Business use statistics.

SHARING
IT pros control OneDrive for Business external sharing by end users.

SYNC
Permits restrictions on the syncing of specific file types on OneDrive for Business. Admins can block syncing on "non-domain joined PCs."

STORAGE
Provides the ability to set default storage limits, as well as how long documents get retained.

DEVICE ACCESS
Permits limits to be set based on the device or network used.

COMPLIANCE
Provides access to controls in the Office 365 Security and Compliance Center portal.

iOS and Android have OneDrive apps, making it easier to get to your OneDrive account.
